Announcement of the Cyprus Stock Exchange on Triena Investments Public Company Ltd (Regulated Market)

The Council of the Cyprus Stock Exchange has requested the approval of the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to the provisions of its Legislation, for the delisting of the titles of Triena Investments Public Company Ltd (Income, Capital, International) from the Regulated Market of the CSE. The Council has reached this decision pursuant to the power conferred upon it by Article 178(1) of the Securities and Cyprus Stock Exchange Law in view of the fact that the conditions for the smooth operation of the stock exchange market in relation to the titles of this company are not satisfied and important ongoing obligations are not complied with. As a result, the interests of investors are put at risk.

More specifically, it is noted that the decision of the CSE Council to delist the company's titles has been reached since the company has not proceeded with the issue and publication of the following financial results:

- i. Its Half-Yearly Financial Report for the period ended 30/6/2020
- ii. Its Annual Financial Report for the year ended 31/12/2020
- iii. Its Half-Yearly Financial Report for the period ended 30/6/2021
- iv. Its Annual Financial Report for the year ended 31/12/2021.

In addition to the above, it is noted that the said company has not proceeded with the issue and publication of its Half-Yearly Financial Report for the period ended 30/06/2022.

Until a relevant response is received by the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission, the company's titles will continue to be suspended.
